New Outlook has been providing services to visually impaired people for over 170 years. Starting out in 1846 as part of the Birmingham Royal Institute for the Blind (BRIB), we became a standalone housing association in 1997.

Since then, we have gone through several changes to become what we are today – a professional, reliable and committed provider that strives to promote personalised services to support independent living for people with sensory or specialist needs.

What is a Care Home?

Our care homes offer high quality accommodation with 24 hour care and support to adults with sensory impairments, acquired brain injury, learning disabilities and other specialist needs. All of our homes are registered and inspected by the CQC.

Located in Selly Oak, Tulip Gardens is a specially designed eight bedroom bungalow providing care for people with a range of complex needs including those with a visual impairment. It has level access to all facilities including the garden. Assistive technology and adaptations are in place to ensure ease of use for those with sensory impairments.


Facilities include:

- Eight single bedrooms
- Optional private phone line
- Care call systems for constant support within bedrooms

All areas are fully accessible for individuals with a visual impairment or physical disability. A variety of route recognition aids are situated around the scheme; with wide hallways and doorways, contrasting décor and flooring and guide rails.

The communal area and spacious grounds offer:

- Assisted bathrooms
- Large lounge
- Dining room
- Kitchen
- Sensory, relaxation room with light therapy technology
- A fully accessible garden
- An activity and games room

Care Partners

Residents at Tulip Gardens are supported by our specialist team who work alongside them to put together a person centred support plan to ensure they can be as independent as possible.

Residents requiring care are considered 'care partners' and are encouraged to take control of their own care with the help of care givers.

Social and community

Selly Oak is a bustling suburb in the south of Birmingham. The scheme is close to the town centre with supermarket, market and a range of shops and leisure facilities. There is also a Post Office and doctor's

surgery close by. There are excellent public transport networks to the local area and Birmingham City Centre.



Payment and access

Referrals are made by your local Social Services department following an assessment of your needs.

The cost of the placement will usually be met by Social Services although they may ask you to contribute to some of the costs.
